NON-RESIDENT BEACH INFORMATION

While summer 2020 is certainly looking different than past years, we are confident that our guests will be able to enjoy our beautiful lakefront and all that it has to offer. In order to remain in compliance with the Governor's Executive order and capacity limitations, please recognize that some changes have been made to insure that you have a safe and fun experience at the beach.

BEACH ACCESS

- The non-resident entrance is located at the north entrance stairs. Look for the Non-Resident Kiosk.
- There is a \$25 daily fee per person.
- We take credit cards only: Visa, MC, Amex, Discover.
- Sorry, no refunds are given.

PARKING

- There is no onsite parking. There are public lots located in the business district and at the train station. It is a short one-mile walk to the lakefront.
- Those interested can purchase a 2020 non-resident parking sticker for the lower north and upper south parking lots for \$910.

OUR STAFF

- Staff will be wearing the appropriate personal protective equipment and will have their temperatures taken prior to each shift. They'll be smiling with their eyes behind those masks!
- Specific equipment will be assigned to each staff member for their use for the summer.
- Staff will be helping to facilitate appropriate social distance spacing.
- Clean, sanitize, & clean some more is our mantra this summer!

FACILITY AMENITIES

- Under the current phase of Restore Illinois there is no swimming allowed.
- To facilitate social distancing, Volleyball, Boating Center rentals, Pavilion rentals, the playground, and shower towers will not be available.
- Concessions will open June 6 with call-in orders and single person pick-up. Sales will be credit/debit card only.
- Bathrooms will be cleaned frequently.

WHAT CAN YOU DO TO HELP?

- Please bring a mask to wear when you go to the bathrooms, concessions, or can't keep a safe 6 ft. social distance.
- Follow our new protocols and procedures. Don't worry... there will be reminder signage everywhere.
