In order to remain in compliance with the Governor's Executive order and capacity limitations, please recognize that some changes have been made to insure that you have a safe and fun experience at the beach.

RESIDENT ACCESS

- All walk-in access to the beach will be at the north entrance stairs by the belvedere. The wooden stairs at the south end are closed.
- Please remember to bring your proof of Lake Forest residency: driver's license, state ID, LFHS school ID (LF, LB, & Knollwood students), Lake Forest College ID, Lake Forest water bill, or a Forest Park Beach ID.

RESIDENT PARKING

- 2019 & 2020 City of Lake Forest vehicle stickers are valid this year at the Lower North Lot and Upper South Lot only. When the lower north parking lot is full it is closed until a space opens up. Staff will be there to help!
- A small number of cars will be allowed to park on the west side of ring road in the reinforced area. These spaces will be directed by staff and when full, parking will no longer be allowed. Parking in this area is for overflow purposes only and not to be filled first.
- The upper south parking lot will remain open to patrons displaying a City of Lake Forest or Beach Parking sticker.
- Lower South Lot parking requires a 2020 watercraft launch, watercraft storage, or South Beach Parking Permit which can be purchased at the sailing office. 2019 permits will not be honored. The protocols for launching a boat have changed and require the greater use of the lot for staging. More information is on our website: www.lfparksandrec.com/boat-launch

FACILITY AMENITIES

- Under the current phase of Restore Illinois there is no swimming allowed.
- To facilitate social distancing, volleyball, boating center rentals, pavilion rentals, the playground, and shower towers will not be available.
- Concessions will open June 6 with call-in orders and single person pick-up. Sales will be credit/debit card only.
- Bathrooms will be cleaned frequently.

WHAT CAN YOU DO TO HELP?

- Please bring a mask to wear when you go to the bathrooms, concessions, or can't keep a safe 6 ft. social distance.
- Follow our new protocols and procedures. Don't worry... there will be reminder signage everywhere.
- Walk or bike to the beach. Don't forget to bring your I.D.
