2BALL COMPETITION RULES

HOW TO PLAY:

- Each two-player team has one minute to score as many baskets as possible from any of the six shooting spots or layups identified on the court.
- Each shooting spot point value is indicated on each shooting spot. Point value range from 2 – 8 points.
- The team with the highest score wins.

GAME RULES:

- One player begins on the half-court line with the ball. The second player begins at any place within the half-court area.

Motion Violations:	Players must pass or dribble the ball from one spot to another. One (1) point will be deducted for each motion violation (Traveling & double-dribbling, palming).
Alternate Shooting:	Teammates must alternate shots. If a player shoots two (2) consecutive baskets, the second basket will not count. Scoring will continue when the second player on the team attempts a basket.
Consecutive Shooting:	A player cannot shoot consecutively from the same spot. All invalid shots will not be counted.
Official Basket:	When shooting a basket, the player must begin with one foot or portion of foot on the shooting spot. Jump shots are allowed.
Layups:	The lay-up is worth (2) points and must be attempted from within a three-foot radius of the basket. Each team can score a maximum of (2) layups. The layup is considered a shooting spot.
Bonus:	(10) point potential 5 points will be allowed to teams that attempt a shot from every spot including a layup. 5 additional points will be awarded to teams that score from every spot including the layup.
